Notifications: Qualified candidates and beneficiaries will be notified on time before the commencing of the programme.

Note: Selection Criteria:

- 1. Fulfilment of the strict admission requirements of St. Paul University (including verification of certificates by the respective authorities.
- 2. Only those below 40 years will be considered.
- 3. Gender parity will be pursued, therefore female applicants are strongly encouraged to apply.
- Regional balance to cover the AACC constituency.
- 5. The amount an applicant contributes to the costs will have an impact on decision to award scholarship.
