TUITION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION - 2020/2021

SCHOLARSHIPS GUIDELINES

The university will award a limited number of partial scholarships, based on the availability of university funds, to academically meritorious and needy students.

University scholarships are provided to assist academically-deserving and needy students. All scholarships and other financial aid already awarded will be taken into consideration when determining eligibility.

Scholarships cover only the first and second academic semesters and students are expected to serve the community in the third semester/optional term.

PART A

I. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Recipients of the university scholarship are required to:

- A. Have a genuine need for financial assistance.
- B. Be ready to be enrolled into a full-time diploma or degree programme.
- C. Be prepared to pay all other expenses charged by the university
- D. Submit duly filled **application form** with certified copies of certificates and academic transcripts.
- E. For new applicants: Must have attained a minimum of a B in KCSE
- F. For continuing students: Must have attained a GPA of at least **60%** in an undergraduate programme or a **credit** in a Diploma programme.

II. SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS

Selections will be based on a student's overall academic or leadership skills, and the commitment to SPU mission and vision.

III. ADVERTISEMENT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

The scholarships will be advertised once a year through various platforms including the website.

IV. NOTICE OF AWARDS

Students will be notified of the outcome of their application by mail or telephone.

V. RENEWAL OF SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarship may be renewed on an academic year basis, depending on the satisfactory academic progress, availability of funds and fulfilment of all requirements.

VI. REVOCATION OF AID

The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to cancel any scholarship awarded at any time if the applicant fails to meet the criteria set out from time to time, if the information given is found to be false and if the student is involved in any form of indiscipline.
