RESEARCH GRANTS FOR POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS

Introduction

Equipping Christian Leadership in an Age of Science (ECLAS) -Africa Project is a regional hub for Africa in partnership with ECLAS-UK, and funded by the John Templeton Foundation. ECLAS Africa is grounded on the perceived conflict between Science and Theology and the need to bridge the gap between the two disciplines for effective policy formulation that promotes life and God's creation. The goal of the project is to develop a contextual theology of science for betterment of African communities by engaging globally and acting locally. We are looking to support the fieldwork expenditure (research grant) for four students whose research interest is on Science and Theology (any field in Science). The maximum amount available for each successful applicant is KES 185,000. One should be a postgraduate student at thesis/dissertation writing stage and targeting to graduate in 2026 or 2027.

How to apply

Prospective applicants should send a brief research concept with the following content;

- i. Project title
- ii. Name, school, year of study, denomination and contact details
- iii. Name of the supervisors and contact details
- iv. Role in the church/denomination of work
- v. The concept paper with the following sections
 - a. Problem statement
 - b. Objectives
 - c. Research design
 - d. Target populations
 - e. Data collection tools
 - f. Timeline
