Off-Campus (Remote) Access Guidelines for Library online resources

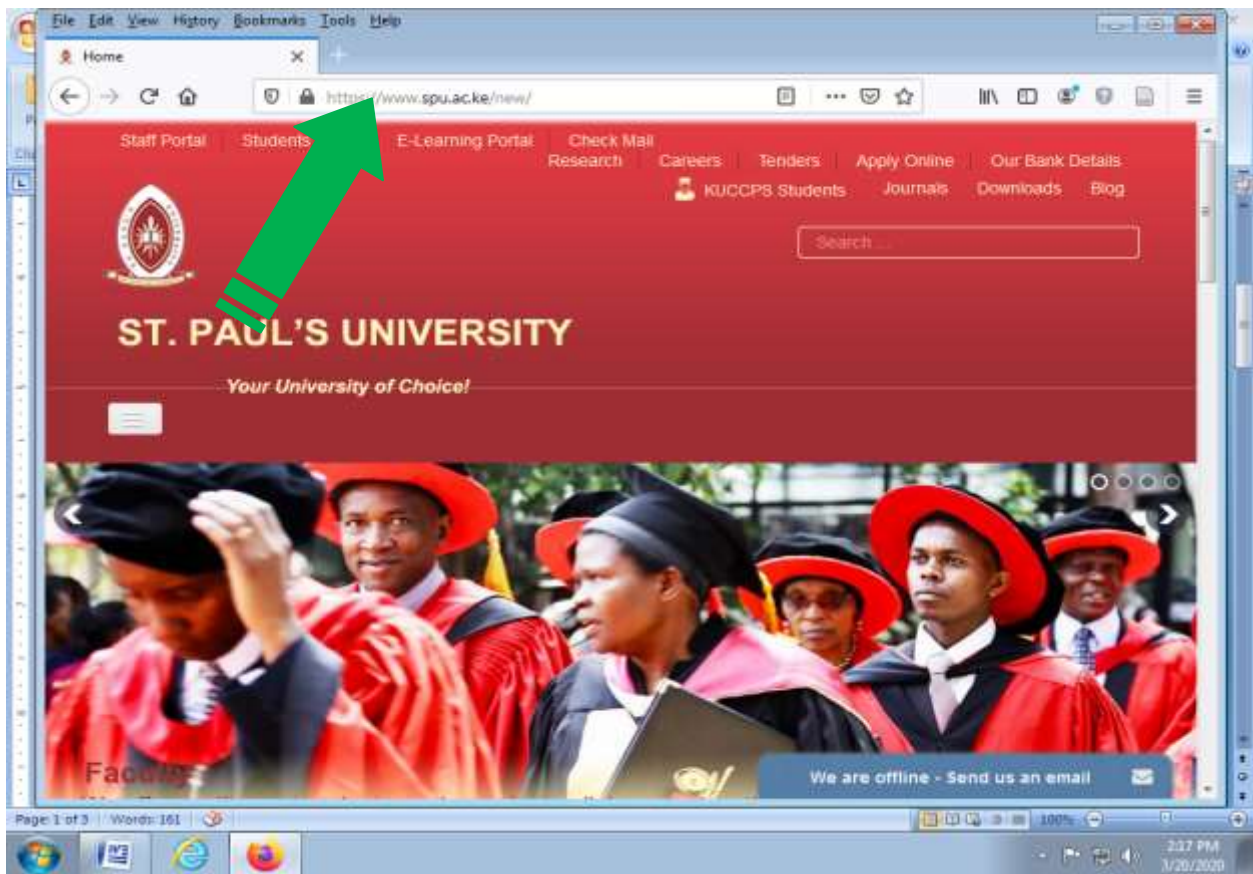
The SPU library uses RemoteX for off-campus (remote) access to online resources

How to:

Step 1: Open a browser e.g Mozilla Firefox, Google Chrome, Internet Explorer

Step 2: Access St. Paul's University website www.spu.ac.ke

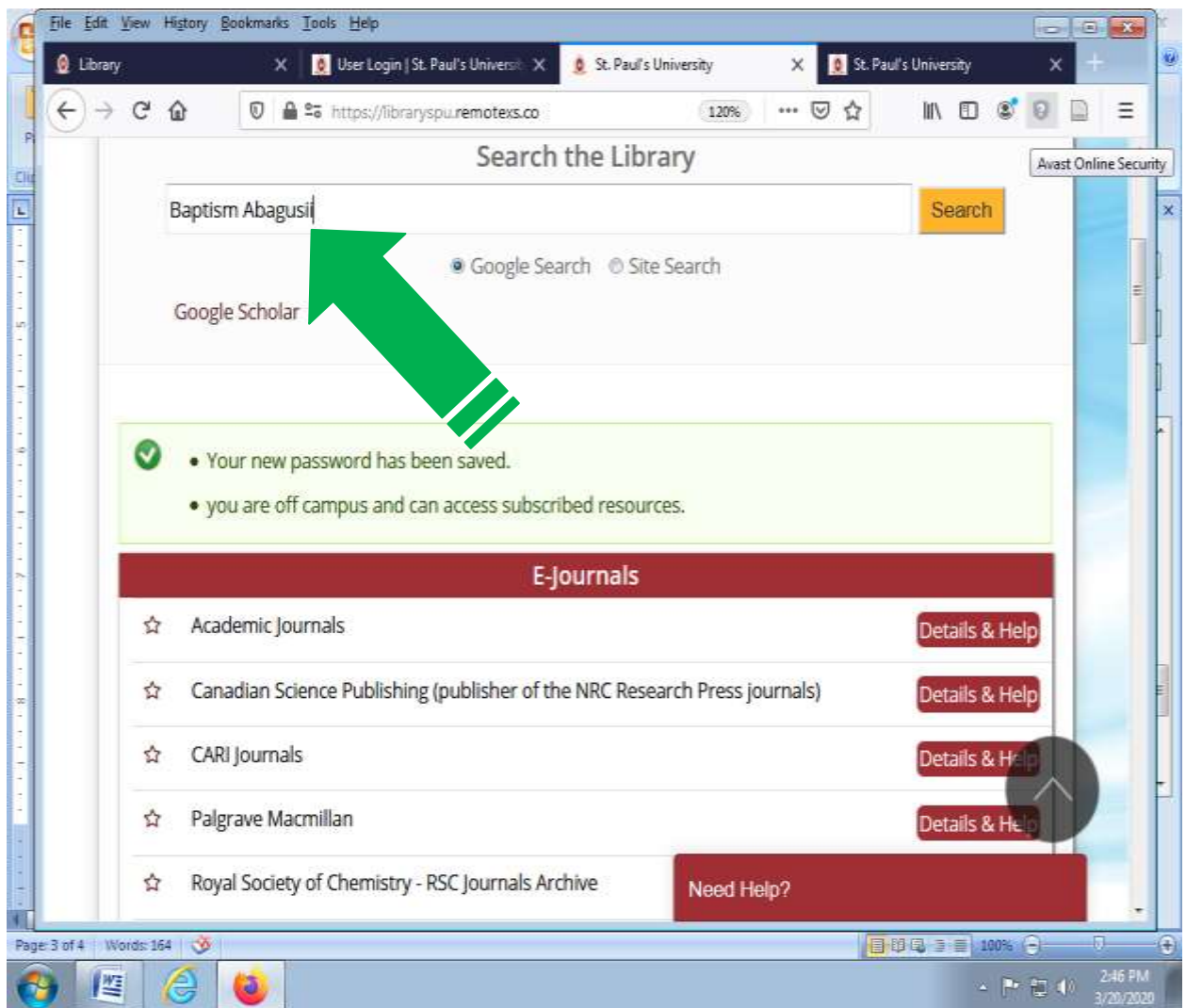
